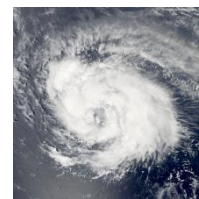




ROR Emergency Information



In the event of a community-wide emergency (hurricane, tornado, fire, flood etc.), the ROR Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) will activate and establish an Incident Command Post (ICP). The ICP will function as the hub for all emergency-related activities and as an information portal.

A sign will be posted at the 4-way Stop to indicate CERT activation

Locations for the ICP, if available, will be:

What should you do?

Once it is safe to do so:

- Evaluate you own situation and notify the ROR CERT of your status.

All residents are asked to contact the Incident Commander to either:

- Notify the team as to the status of their own property, personnel and pets
- Request assistance &/or information
- Volunteer themselves &/or their resources



Regardless of whether you have notified the ICP, if the status at your property is OK, please place the silver flag that has been issued to you at the end of your driveway. This will notify Search & Rescue Teams and help save valuable time.

If we neither hear from you, nor see a silver flag at your driveway, we will send in a Search & Rescue team to evaluate your situation.

1. Tune in to 99.7 FM (KSTAR COUNTRY) for local emergency information
2. Tune in to 740 AM (KTRH) for Houston Regional emergency information
3. Keep in contact with the ROR Incident Command Post for updates
