



ROR Emergency Information

In the event of a community-wide emergency (hurricane, tornado, fire, flood etc.), the ROR Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) will activate and establish an Incident Command Post (ICP). The ICP will function as the hub for all emergency-related activities and as an information portal.

A sign will be posted at the 4-way Stop to indicate CERT activation

Locations for the ICP will be, in this order (based on availability):

1. **Home of Lis & Alex Crabtree – 10961 Lake Forest Dr.** (east of OCR approx. 0.6 mile on right) Landline: 936-321-8720 Cell: 936-827-5694
2. **Home of Gary & Jane Jenkins – 10881 LFD.** (east of OCR approx.. 1.35 mile on right) Landline: (281) 292-9243 Cell: (281) 636-1558
3. **Home of Maryann Fox & Doug Fuchs – 10968 LFD.** (east of OCR approx. 0.5 mile on left) Cell: (936) 718-1317 or (936) 718-1318

What should you do?

Once it is safe to do so:

- Evaluate you own situation and notify the ROR CERT of your status.

All residents are asked to contact the Incident Commander to either:

- Notify the team as to the status of their own property, personnel and pets
- Request assistance &/or information
- Volunteer themselves &/or their resources



If the status at your property is OK, please place the provided silver flag at the end of your driveway. If you don't have or can't find your silver flag, please use a piece of aluminum foil as a suitable flag. This will notify Search & Rescue Teams and save valuable time.

If we neither hear from you, nor see a silver flag at your driveway, we will send in a Search & Rescue team to evaluate your situation.
